Annual Incorporation Report – Due to the Secretary of State's office by June 15th. Cost to renew \$40.00.

Buddy Poppies – If not prepaid, Posts owing money for Poppies: Orders received with no date of sale are due upon receipt of shipment. Orders received with a sale date are due 10 days after sale. Failure to do so could cost your post the privilege of voting at Department Convention.
